

Outdoor First Aid

Pre-requisite for this course

Current Workplace First Aid Certificate *Unit Standard 6402 6401 6400*

Copy of this is required at time of booking

This unit standard is intended for people who wish, or are required, to manage emergency care for a period of two to twelve hours during an outdoor recreation activity.

People credited with this unit standard can explain long-term management requirements for an emergency care situation in an outdoor recreation environment and assess and manage a patient's condition long-term in an outdoor recreation environment.

The Outdoor First Aid course focuses on Leadership, Group management and Patient management during an Outdoor Recreation Activity away from outside help.

It is held at a venue about 20kms out of Tauranga in a rural bush setting.

The course comprises a mix of theory and practical scenarios which will be run outside, rain or shine.

Participants should refresh their knowledge of the core competencies in a workplace first aid course (patient assessment, signs/symptoms and treatment of medical conditions) prior to attending the day.
